<p>Monday 4th December</p>	<p>The staff team meets today. Pray that they would catch any loose ends for the Christmas period. Pray that books ministry would be valuable this Christmas, both through giveaways and the bookstall.</p>
<p>Tuesday 5th December</p>	<p>Pray that relationships between families at Little Stars continue to grow. We meet to pray this evening, 745 for 8pm at the Memorial Hall. Pray that this evening God would oversee the meeting at Swanland setting vision for Hull Deanery with the Bishop of Hull.</p>
<p>Weds 6th December</p>	<p>Thank God for St Luke's Toddler Group. Pray that the leaders' vision for families to join the church on Sundays would be met under God.</p>

<p>Sunday 10th December</p>	<p>We meet this morning at St Luke's and St Andrew's. Pray that we would grow in faith and love as we set our hearts of the certain hope of the gospel.</p> <p>This afternoon and evening is City Carols. Pray that very many people are born again as they encounter Jesus.</p>
<p>Monday 11th December</p>	<p>Pray that the children at Springhead School would want to follow Jesus as they hear more about him in this morning's assembly.</p>
<p>Tuesday 12th December</p>	<p>Growth Groups all meet this week. Give thanks for the past term, and pray that the word would dwell richly in each member.</p>
<p>Weds 13th December</p>	<p>Pray for a fun time at the St Luke's Toddler Group Christmas Party.</p> <p>Pray that Morning Carols (10:30am, St Andrew's) would be a great opportunity to celebrate the birth of Jesus for those who prefer to be out during daylight hours.</p>
<p>Thursday 14th December</p>	<p>Give thanks that Pub Night (tonight, 7pm at the Wheatsheaf) has been a good opportunity to chew over aspects of Christianity.</p>

Friday 15th December	Pray that many people would come to the Christingle service after school at St Luke's, and that some hear the gospel for the first time. Pray that the Impact Christmas Party would build friendships between members, and be lots of fun.
Saturday 16th December	Give thanks for all those who work behind the scenes cleaning, keeping our buildings and grounds in good order, working in administration and finance, and many other roles.
Sunday 17th December	Give thanks that many people still attend traditional carol services. Pray that very many would come to this evening's Carols By Candlelight services at St Andrew's.
Monday 18th December	Give thanks for those who make the churches look beautiful with flowers and decorations, especially at Christmas.
Tuesday 19th December	St Andrew's School visit St Andrew's Church for their Christmas services today. Pray that the gospel would be heard and believed by many.
Weds 20th December	Pray for the children and staff of Springhead School as they visit St Luke's today. Pray that they would enjoy celebrating the birth of Jesus.
Thursday 21st December	Give thanks that Carr Lane School are visiting St Luke's today . Pray that some would want to return on Sundays. Pray for John and Sally as they take a Christmas assembly at Wold Academy this afternoon, and ask God to soften the hearts to the gospel of children and staff alike.
Friday 22nd December	Praise God for the work Friendship Club does among older people in the community.
Saturday 23rd December	Give thanks for all our musicians . Pray that they would be able to worship God through their playing.
Christmas Eve	Pray that all our services today – morning services, all age Christmas Eve at St Andrew's, Traditional Carols at St Luke's, late night Christmas Communion at St Andrew's – would clearly and engagingly point to the saviour of the world.

Christmas Day	Joy to the world, the Lord has come! Spend some time today praising God for Jesus.
Boxing Day	Pray for those who are lonely and those struggling financially this Christmas. Pray that they would know God's love for them in Jesus.
Weds 27th December	Ask God to fan into flame the gospel in the hearts of very many people who will have heard it in our parishes and beyond this month, and that there would be a bumper harvest of new Christians this Christmas .
Thursday 28th December	Think back over the last year and give thanks to God for something he's done in your life or the life of our churches. If you can think of more than one, keep going until you run out.
Friday 29th December	Pray for Lee and Emma who are being married at St Luke's today. Pray that they would grow in their knowledge of and love for Jesus over the months and years to come.
Saturday 30th December	Pray for Rosie Featherstone and Nick Sharp who are being married at St Andrew's today. Pray for a joyful, Christ-centred celebration.
Sunday 31st December	We meet today to worship the Lord of the years at St Luke's and St Andrew's this morning. Pray that we would individually and corporately commit to him once again.
